- Assisting the age group coach(es) to deliver fun and structured football sessions on a weekly basis
- Help plan and evaluate sessions as you get to know the pupils and coach(es)

- Be aware of the club's Health and Safety policy and Emergency Procedures.

Time Commitment: 1 hours per week, with 10-15mins set up/end of session
