Higher Modern Studies London Trip

The class are currently studying the topic of Democracy in the UK; part of this course involves looking at the work undertaken by our MPs at Westminster. Following a discussion with the education department in Westminster and the school's senior management team we are pleased that the pupils will have an opportunity to visit the Parliament on Monday the 6th November 2017. The course we will be attending is focussed on 'People and parliament'.

We have secured 20 seats on the Caledonian Sleeper leaving at 11pm on Sunday 5th November 2017. We will travel overnight and arrive in London just after 9am. At 3pm in the afternoon we will attend a course at the Parliament then return on the train at 9pm, arriving back in Pitlochry just after 6am on Tuesday 7th November. The cost for the trip covers the transport which, thanks to the parliament travel bursary, is £56.50 per person.

Our itinerary for the day in London, prior to visiting the parliament, is still in discussion as we would like the pupils to be involved in the planning of this. We will be looking into free activities and will have a more definitive plan after the October break. Pupils are welcoming to bring money to purchase meals or they can bring their own if they prefer. We will look for a buffet restaurant close to the station before boarding the train home.
