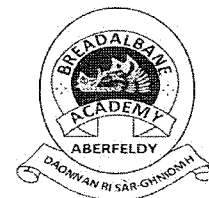

P7 Transition

In order to make the transition from P7 to S1 as smooth as possible, we have arranged a series of events over the coming months to give all pupils time to meet and work with our staff and partner agencies as well as an opportunity to become familiar with their new surroundings.

On Thursday 10th May we have planned a day of team building events and this will be led by Skills Development Scotland, Community Link Worker, our Active Schools Co-ordinator and our Greenspace Ranger. This event will start at 9am and pupils should wear clothing suitable for sports activities, outdoor activities and bring with them a pair of wellington boots and a waterproof jacket. On arrival at school pupils should go to the dining centre.

On Friday 11th May we have the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) day. This is run by the Science, Maths and Technology departments.
