Activity

Now Draw an ECO Cartoon Character

1. Lesson Introduction: Talk about why we Reduce, Re-use, Recycle and check out the film clips on YouTube if you can – see resources.

Main Points: - rubbish is harming our planet so we are all trying to reduce rubbish – plastic, card, metal etc. and save the resources of our planet. Re-using something and not throwing it away is best…even recycling uses energy (and resources such

	as electricity are needed to make something new out of some plastic can create hazards in the ocean and damages wildlife a energy, keeping our air, oceans, and land clean and healthy for think: How could I reduce, re-use and recycle? Think about a Plan: Get today's resources together – example cartoons from	or humans, animals, and plants to survive. a fun character I could create to help me and my family.	
	 Sky Room, P1 – 3 4. Using A4 paper draw a cartoon character with an Eco Theme (see pictures below). 5. Give your character a name and write a sentence about what they will do to help! e.g. Marvellous Mel the dog that sorts our recycling! Extension Fold another A4 sheet into 4 by folding in half, then half again to make quarters. Beginning Middle Middle End Draw a cartoon story with a beginning, middle and end. Try to add a caption or a speech bubble in each square 	4. Using A4 paper fold your page into 6 squares – turn your page to landscape, then fold 2 sides in the middle so that they overlap exactly. Then fold in half from bottom to top. Unfold – this makes 6 squares. 5. Now create your character and a cartoon story with an Eco theme! E.g. Sam the Super Spaniel Saves the Planet! 6. Make sure you have a caption and/or a speech bubble in each square, so we know what is happening. 7. Send a picture of your cartoon to gw09boydsusan2@glow.sch.uk


