







Cartoon Lion

Mrs Boyd's Cartoon Lion








<u>Zentangle – personal template – create your own pattern</u> <u>ideas...see example template below</u>

Zentungle Patterns





Take your time, repeat some patterns if you like, but see how many different zig-zag lines, dots, swirls etc. you can come up with....

Zentangle Art Project

- 1. Create your own Zentangle Template with 10 12 patterns of your own...try to mix it up with wavy lines, circles, squares, dots, crosses...anything you like (see pictures below)
- 2. Use an A4 page and draw a border with a ruler size is about 28.5 cm x 20 cm.
- 3. Draw about 6 wavy lines from 1 side or corner of the page to the other, the lines should crossover to make different areas for your doodle patterns.
