Choose a character from your favourite book or one you have recently read and fill in the table telling us all about your chosen character.

#### **Predictor sheet**

Choose a book you have never read before and read the first page and make a prediction (guess) on what you think will happen in the book. Use the cover and contents to help you with your prediction.

#### **Learning Intention:**

To discover what different suffixes and prefixes mean and to use them in context.

#### Activity:

A prefix is a stem of a word found at the beginning of a word and a suffix is a stem of a word found at the end of a word. Both can change the meaning a word.

#### **Learning Intention:**

To make a given amount of money using 1p,2p,5p,10p,20p, 50p, £1 and £2 coins.

#### Task 1

Similar to yesterday using the sheet (on website and Teams) note in your jotter or class notebook the coins you would need to buy each item on the page. This sheet is more challenging than yesterday as it goes above £1.

Remember you can only use:

1p,2p,5p,10p,20p, 50p, £1 and £2 coins.

\*top tip: start with the biggest coin first then work your way down.

e.g. for £1.62p you could use a £1, 50p, 10p and a 2p.
