Biodiversity Project

On your Sway you should now have:

- A fact file about your chosen topic
- Information to explain Biodiversity
- Information to explain why Biodiversity is important to humans and how we conserve can conserve it

Today add to the Sway answering these questions:

- How does your plant or animal or habitat benefit other plants or animals? Give at least 3 examples with details.
- Draw a picture or a mind map to show how your plant, animal or habitat benefits other species. Be detailed in your responses.



If you are working with a partner, you can divide the tasks, but you should be producing a more detailed presentation than someone working on their own.
