( $\underline{-}-\underline{i}-b b-o-n$ )"

" Think of a word which starts with the same sound: (rock)
- Think of another word which rhymes " with it: (gibbon)
Clap out the number of syllables:
(ribb/on - 2)
Can you grow the word or shrink the word (ribbons or ribboning)
Can you say the word without the /r/?
(ibbon)
Can you say the word with /t/ ".instead of $/ n / \quad$ (ribbot)
