1. Boggis was counting his chickens in the morning. Last night, he had 12 chickens. This morning, he has 5 less. How many chickens does he have left?








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4. James wanted to visit lots of countries in the giant peach. There were 13 he wanted to visit. They went to 8 of them. How many were

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7. The BFG is filling up his case with dream jars. His case holds 12 jars. He has 5 jars so far. How many more does he need to put in to fill it?



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10. The witches sat at tables of 5 to listen to the grand high witch. How many witches were there if there were 7 tables?



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
11. George needed 12 pills to make his marvellous medicine. If they came in packets of 2, how many packets would he need?






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15. Danny needs to get the raisins ready for the pheasants. He puts two in each cone. How many cones can he fill with 24 raisins?
