Rouge & Bleu – Year 2; Vert – Year 3 & 4. Select ‘Tricky Words’ and complete one of the tricky words lists. (This will be the last week we will have ‘look, cover, write, check’ on the plan, but you can all still do it as it is good practice. 😊) <p>➤ To prepare for the debate on the live lesson on Wednesday. Choose a side: School is better than home school. (you decide if you are FOR i.e. school is better; or AGAINST i.e. home school is better). <h2>Tuesday</h2>	<p>** Time Capsule - Task 2 **</p> <p>Learning Intention: To write a letter</p> <p>Activity: Write or type (if you have a printer) a letter to your future self. Tell yourself about the strange situation that we are living in just now, as well as what you normally enjoy doing. Ask your parent to also write a letter about you that could go in your time capsule. They could keep it a secret from you and you could read it in ten years' time!</p>	<p>Learning Intention: I am working with coins and notes of different values.</p> <p>Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Topmarks – Daily Ten <p>Complete challenges set on Sumdog relating to work with money.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: to make something edible and creative</p> <p>Activity: Choose 5 ingredients from your fridge or cupboard. Post your ingredients, a photo of your creation and a review from any family member who has eaten what you have made on P5 Teams – Home Learning. *Remember to ask permission from an adult before you start. And don't waste food – you only need to use small amounts.</p>
<h2>Wednesday</h2>	<p>** Time Capsule – Task 3 **</p> <p>Learning Intention: To read and collect media articles</p> <p>Activity: There are lots of articles in the media just now about Coronavirus and its impact on us and the planet. Go onto a reliable media source such as Newsround https://www.bbc.co.uk/newsround#more-stories-2 or look through a newspaper you have at home, and choose a few articles that you would like to include in your time capsule that you think your 19/20 year old self would be interested to read.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: to increase in speed and accuracy in mental maths & times tables</p> <p>Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Topmarks - Daily 10 • Times Tables Game: What is the question? Look at the sheet – What is the Question and see how many multiplication questions you can write for each answer given. Some only have one answer. When you have found at least one answer for each, check your answers against the answer sheet. If you cannot access sumdog please practise your fact families and times tables. 	<p>** Time Capsule – Task 4 **</p> <p>Learning Intention: to gather special mementos</p> <p>Activity: Find a nice piece of paper or card and draw around your hand. It will be interesting to see how much bigger it is when you open your time capsule. Now ask if you can print a couple of recent photos or draw a picture of yourself now. It will be fun to look back on these in 10 years' time.</p>
<p>Friday</p>	<p>** Time Capsule – Task 5 **</p> <p>Learning Intention: to capture memories</p> <p>Activity: Ask each of your family members to write a little list of things about you / memories. For ideas see #3 in this article: http://www.mykidsadventures.com/time-capsule/ This suggests putting each list in a small envelope. You could do this by making small envelopes or put all of the lists together in one larger envelope. Remember to ask your family members to write their name and date on it.</p> <p>Learning Intention: to perform basic joins</p> <p>Activity: Complete two pages of handwriting booklet. Use handwriting pen where possible. Self-assess your work with a 😊 above the best one on each line.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: to increase in speed of recall / to solve maths problems</p> <p>Activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Topmarks - Daily 10 Problem Solving. See sheet on Teams – P5 – Maths - Files or on the school website.
