If you need to see an English version of Going on a Bear Hunt, there are plenty online.</p> <p>Today and tomorrow, set up your own bear hunt and record it (in a series of short videos or in photos). This can be done outside in the garden or you could create the bear hunt in miniature using toys indoors.</p> <p>What will you need to take with you? How long will you be gone? Where will you go (forest/swamp, etc). Can you sing the song as you go?</p> <p>A bheil an t-EAGAL ort?? (are you SCARED??)</p> <p>(remember to make a cave for your bear to hide in!)</p> <p>Have you practised writing your Fuaimean words today?</p>	<p>Learning Intention: to identify halves and quarters</p> <p>Activity: fraction sheets</p> <p>Circles: Bloigh Half</p> <p>Squares: Bloigh Half</p> <p>Pentagons: Bloigh Half & Quarter</p> <p>Rectangles: Bloigh Half & Quarter</p> <p>Extension: in your jotter, can you make up your own half or quarter puzzle?</p>	<p>Learning Intention: I am learning that my nose influences more than just my sense of smell.</p> <p>Activity:</p> <p>Your nose doesn’t just smell things, it has other uses as well!</p> <p>Today, when you eat or drink something, try holding your nose as closed as you can.</p> <p>What happens?</p> <p>Why do you think this happens?</p> <p>Write up your findings on Teams 😊</p>

Make a fist, then pop up each number, counting up as you go. Squares, Pentagons, Rectangles: Try this times tables game online (2x) http://www.learnyourtables.co.uk/en/index2.htm</p>	<p>Learning Intention: Using recall to identify an object by its smell.</p> <p>Activity: You will need someone else to help you do this.</p> <p>Take turns select items from around the house that have a particular smell. One person picks, while the other is blindfolded and must guess what they are smelling. Easy...right? Try to make it as tricky as possible!</p>
<h1>Friday</h1>	<p>Learning Intention: to recognise, read and write familiar words</p> <p>Activity: Have a very quick look at your Fuaimean word sheet.</p> <p>P1: say and write each word. Can you remember which letter comes first, next, last?</p> <p>P2/3 – ask an adult to say the words, and you write them down without looking at the sheet. How did you do?</p>	<p>Learning Intention: to use known tactical strategies when playing maths games</p> <p>Activity: Play the game 11s Find some soft toys and arrange them in a circle like we did in the Maths lesson last week. Choose your favourite toy to start, and play the game like we do in class, except you will have to say all the numbers for your toys. Who will be out first? Who do you think is going to win? Try using a different number of toys next time. who do you think will win this time?
