

<p>Literacy</p> <p>This term the class will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Extend the range and sophistication of questions they ask and answer about what they read and watch or listen to. ➤ Give a short talk to classmates, focussing on pace and volume. ➤ Use punctuation and layout to read with greater fluency. ➤ Discuss characterisation and the author's technique. ➤ Use 'show not tell' to create interesting characters ➤ Check that writing makes sense and meets the purpose. ➤ Set targets in writing – and strive to meet them. ➤ Check written work against success criteria. 	<p>Numeracy</p> <p>This term the class will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Extend knowledge of rounding and use to estimate or check answers. ➤ Recognise and decompose whole numbers into the millions. ➤ Work with numbers less than zero. ➤ Independently choose which operation is best to solve a problem. ➤ Investigate where fractions are used in real life and solve related problems. ➤ Create a set of equivalent fractions. ➤ Link fractions, percentages and decimals.
