S3 Tracking Report

Please find enclosed a Tracking Report for your son/daughter that is designed to provide you with information on current progress and next steps for learning in all of the subject areas that are being studied this year. Please note that this information is reflective of progress made since new courses started in May and not just since pupils have returned from the summer holidays.

This attached report is the first that has been issued in our revised Tracking and Monitoring system that we have implemented this year. In our new system, instead of having 1 report per year with extended comment, there will now be 2 reports issued both containing shorter comments, the second of these reports being issued on Monday 12th November 2018.

These reports are supplemented by a parental information evening on Thursday 24th January 2019 where the opportunity for discussion with all class teachers is provided. The focus of these conversations is on pupil progress, next steps for learning and recommendations for subject choices in S4.

Between these reports and the parents evening, if there is any concern regarding pupil progress in learning then an Intervention Letter will also be sent home outlining the concern and any required strategies for improvement.

On Monday 27th August we also launched Show My Homework to all S3 pupils and I hope that both you and your son/daughter are able to engage with this resource and are finding it of benefit. Information of all homework tasks set will now be posted on Show My Homework and parents/guardians and pupils have their own individual access to maximise communication and support with organisation. Access details have been issued to pupils in class and to parents via a letter on Monday 27th August. If you haven't received log in details, are having technical issues or have any general questions regarding Show My Homework then please don't hesitate to contact the school office.
