

<p>Literacy:</p> <p>Reading: Finishing Jolly Phonics sounds, progressing to blending short words. Starting ORT Reading Scheme, moving from picture book to basic words.</p> <p>Listening and Talking: Discussing feelings and emotions linked to HWB. Talking about books, their stories and characters.</p> <p>Writing: Continuing story writing through scribing. Increasing formal writing opportunities; introducing finger spaces and full stops through weekly news and Halloween and Christmas activities.</p>	<p>Numeracy:</p> <p>Mental maths: Recounting numbers 0 -20 forward and backwards; ordering and filling in missing numbers.</p> <p>Understanding terms more/less, after/before/in between and directional language. Matching numbers to words and adding / subtracting to 10.</p>
<p>Health & Wellbeing:</p> <p>Learning about friendship, emotions and fairness. How we understand these terms, and how people can help us.</p> <p>Social Dance – Learning some Scottish Ceilidh dances; moving in time to music and recalling steps.</p> <p>P.E. – Ball skills – how to aim and throw underarm to a target and show turn taking in team games.</p>	<p>Contexts for Learning:</p> <p>Topic this term is Toys / Robots.
