


<p>Language and Literacy activities including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading groups in class. Read chapters for homework. Use Bloom’s Taxonomy questions for reading tasks. Bloom’s questioning extends and develops comprehension skills. • Listening and talking in Birks Bag Company: advertising campaign, songs, raps, video ads, radio, assembly, social media. • Document WW1 and write newspaper reports from different points of view (soldiers, support at home, animals who worked on the Front) • Write reports in the form of a diary for our Enterprise project. Document all tasks with examples of work (photos, excel spreadsheets, graphs) and include thoughts and feelings about skills for life, learning and work. 		<p>Mathematics and Numeracy activities including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revise and extend our understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages. • Continue maths groups and homework routine. Begin weekly mental maths tests that correspond to homework tasks. • Practise and revise calculations using the four operations and be able to explain steps to a partner. Discuss and use BODMAS • Extension tasks using Daily Rigour and problem solving challenges. • Examine money in society, how is it used, how do we pay for things? What does debit and credit mean? Revise money calculations; relate this to work on decimals. • Complete budgeting task: Enterprise topic, food for a family, caring for a pet. 			
<p>Health & Wellbeing activities including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue with new cooperative learning groups. Play games to encourage praise, participation, group success and class success. • Start Gratitude Diaries to focus on things we are thankful for in our lives. • Complete block of Yoga in gym, concentrating on strength and mindfulness. • Encourage use of personal free writing jotters to record thoughts and feelings. • Reflect on the impact that WW1 had on society and the lives it changed. 		<p>Contexts for Learning: This term we will continue to work on our Birks Bag Company project. We will be selling our bags to parents, in the community at local shops and at various community groups and events.
