Careers Event and Options Information Evening

We would like to formally invite you to our Careers Event and Options Information Evening which take place on **Thursday 31st January 2019 between 4-6pm**. This event will have a flexible and informal format with around 80 stalls being situated in the school for you and your son/daughter to move around at your own comfort asking specific questions relating to option choices and potential career paths.

This event will run for 2 hours but you are welcome to come and go at any point within this time; however there will be a short presentation at 4.45pm in the Assembly Hall providing an overview of the school curriculum and option choice process.

This event is being delivered with the support of over 60 of our partners including employers, colleges and universities from all over the country (see full list of partners below), alongside the Principal Teachers from all subject departments within our school.

The aim of this event is to ensure that all pupils and parents have an overview of the school curriculum, understand the option choice processes and the supports available within it.

Also, it is a fantastic opportunity to discuss potential subject choices with teachers and to explore exactly what each course actually entails. Given the vast number of partners present it is also a wonderful chance to explore potential career paths, confirm the qualifications that are required in a specific industry and receive general information and advice.

2pm-3.40pm: S2-6 students attend and engage with 80 stall holders

4pm-6pm: S2-6 parents/guardians and pupils attend and engage with 80 stall holders

4.45pm-5pm: S2-5 parents/guardians attend presentation in Assembly Hall on school curriculum and option choice process
