

<p>Literacy:</p> <p>Reading: Working through ORT Reading Scheme. Developing range of tricky words and understanding question words. Understanding features on fiction and non-fiction books.</p> <p>Listening and Talking: Finding out new information to help make choices and learn new things. Being able to ask questions about learning.</p> <p>Writing: Continuing story writing through scribing and starting to write own basic sentences. Forming letters correctly and developing control to write on the line and space words out.</p>	<p>Numeracy:</p> <p>Mental maths: Language associated with shape, time and measure. Addition and subtraction to 10.</p> <p>Increasing number knowledge by counting to and from 20. A strong focus on subtraction within 10 and links to addition. Exploring 2D shape and introducing 3D shapes within the environment. Starting to measure length and weight using non-standard measurements.</p>
<p>Health & Wellbeing:</p> <p>Continuing with friendship, emotions and fairness through co-operative working. How we understand these terms and how individual skills contribute to our school.</p> <p>Social and creative dance – Learning some Scottish Ceilidh dances; moving in time to music and recalling steps and developing our own moves and dances, responding to different music.</p> <p>P.E. – Team games to build on co-operative skills.</p>	<p>Contexts for Learning:</p> <p>We are first finishing our Toys / Robots topic, testing out forces – push / pull and effects of friction.</p> <p>Scots – to celebrate Burns Day we are exploring favourite Scots words, learning poems and reading / acting out The Gruffalo in Scots.</p> <p>Dinosaurs – We will close the term with a dinosaur topic: naming and categorising types of dinosaur; discovering fossils; exploring non-fiction books and creating our own dinosaur fact files.</p>
