

Literacy-

This term the class will:

- Read closely, between the lines, and to evaluate the writer's craft.
- Uplevel sentences to include better vocabulary, openers, punctuation and connectives.
- Learn by heart and present to the class a Scots poem.
- Learn to take notes and present information on well-known Scientists.
- Use punctuation and layout to read with greater fluency.
- Read a classic novel and create a Book Trailer.
- Check that writing makes sense and meets the purpose.
- Set targets in writing – and strive to meet them.
- Check written work against success criteria.

Numeracy-

This term the class will:

- Learn to estimate and measure lengths, areas, weights and volumes.
- Choose the best instrument or method to measure the above.
- Choose the most appropriate unit of measure.
- Create and answer measure problems.
- Revisit and consolidate addition, subtraction, division and multiplication
- Work towards a secure grasp of all times tables.
- Choose individual work within Time and aim to master telling the time, interpreting timetables or the relationships between time, speed and distance.

Health & Wellbeing-

This term the class will:

- Work to improve agility, stamina, pace and accuracy.
- Learn to use the language of creative dance – shapes, levels, pathways, motifs.
- Increase fitness and stamina with cross country running and orienteering.
- Learn to deal with emergency situations including an unconscious casualty, a serious bleed or a choking incident and to recognise the symptoms of a heart attack.

- Explore Green Screen technology.
