P7 Transition

In order to make the transition from P7 to S1 as smooth as possible, we have arranged a series of events over the coming months to give all pupils time to meet and work with our staff and partner agencies as well as an opportunity to become familiar with their new surroundings.

On Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th May we have planned two days of activities involving school staff and partners e.g. Skills development Scotland. This event will start at 9am each day. Pupils do not need to wear school uniform but should bring with them clothing suitable for sports activities, outdoor activities and a waterproof jacket. On arrival at school pupils should go to the dining centre.

On both days pupils may purchase lunch from the school canteen, the cost is approximately £2.10, or alternatively bring a packed lunch. Both days will be held at Breadalbane Academy and will finish at approximately 3pm allowing time for travel home.

The residential experience to Comrie Croft is on Monday 27th to Wednesday 29th May 2019. Final details regarding activities, clothing and footwear will follow after the Easter holidays.

The final part of the programme is the two day visit to Breadalbane Academy on Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th June. On arrival at school pupils should go to the dining centre where they will be met by members of the Senior Management Team and prefects who will show them around the school. During this visit the pupils will follow their new timetable and meet with their new teachers. Pupils will also be given a free school meal courtesy of Tayside Contracts. All pupils should wear their primary school uniform.



We look forward to meeting everyone in May and we hope that these activities will enable all pupils to become comfortable with their new school environment and their new peer group.
