I can read simple words and am beginning to learn some tricky words. I can compose a sentence and write it with help. I can think of and ask a visitor an appropriate question. I can listen carefully to other people and take turns. I am enjoying learning a range of new words that link to my topic.</p>	<p>Numeracy:</p> <p>I continue to use a range of materials to help me 'count on and back' to develop my understanding of addition and subtraction. I am developing my knowledge of shape, measure, pattern, maths relationships and concepts in real world contexts such as our indoor and outdoor space and the garden. I know the days of the week, the months of the year and the seasons. I can describe the concept of time through the use of calendars, timetables and clocks and can relate this to my everyday life.</p>
<p>Health & Wellbeing:</p> <p>I can talk about my feelings. I understand the notion of Growth Mindset and that some things I can do now and some things I have to work at because I am not there yet. I can use the 3 and/or 5 point visual scale to explain how I feel. I can follow my plan with support. I am working on my fine and gross motor skills in a range of contexts. I continue to learn about the importance of personal space and personal safety. I am working at developing my independent and group working skills. I can enjoy making and growing in the context of the Garden.</p>	<p>Contexts for Learning: Houses and Homes</p> <p>I can describe and identify different types of Houses and Homes. I can ask questions about different types of Houses and Homes. I can think about the Houses and Homes people and animals have or have had in the past.
