### **New Timetable and Uniform**

Our new timetable takes effect from Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> May when all pupils will begin courses that they will study for the duration of the new academic year. As happens every year, teachers will have new classes to teach and they will be establishing their own clear routines and expectations for the year ahead.

As a whole school, we feel this timetable change is also timely to reinforce our uniform expectations of all pupils. These high expectations have not changed from those that we have worked with throughout this school year and which have been adhered to very well by the vast majority of our pupils. We are however seeing a small increase in the number of pupils wearing leggings, tracksuit bottoms and coloured trainers, all of which are not part of the Breadalbane Academy school uniform. As is outlined in our uniform guidelines, attached to this letter, pupils not in full school uniform will be asked for a reason for non-compliance and appropriate contact made with home, either by groupcall message or phone call.

## Breadalbane Academy – School Uniform Guidelines 2018/19

School uniform is well established at Breadalbane Academy supporting our positive school ethos whilst allowing us to develop our school values of *Belonging, Believing, Aspiring and Achieving* for every pupil. Our school uniform includes the following items;

## **Blazers**



It has been agreed that school blazers (with braid) will be worn by all prefects and house captains.

Blazers (without braid) are available as an option for all other pupils.

## **Consequences**

If a pupil is in school without school uniform then the parents/guardians will be notified by text message. If the problem is persistent then contact home will be made by the pupils Guidance Teacher.

If a pupil has forgotten their school tie then a temporary replacement can be borrowed from the school office with a deposit being left to ensure it is returned at the end of the day.
