S3 Munro Experience

As part of our universal outdoor education programme we intend again this session to provide every young person in S3 with the opportunity to climb a "Munro" mountain. These are mountains that are over 3000 feet or more that tower over our landscape. As we are located in a spectacular setting, it is fitting that every young person attending Breadalbane Academy should be able to say that they have climbed a Munro. The date for this walk for pupils in Mhor and Lawers is Tuesday 11th June 2019.

This will take place in the Ben Lawers area and will be subsidised by the school to encourage participation by all. There is no cost to the pupils for the day.

Pupil participating in the Munro climb will need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle and be dressed appropriately for a day on the mountain. Equipment required includes a rucksack, waterproof jacket and waterproof trousers, warm hat, warm and waterproof gloves, sunscreen, strong footwear or walking boots. There are waterproof jackets and waterproof trousers available for pupils to use at school. If your child requires to borrow these, they should notify staff in advance.
