Scottish National Standardised Assessments

Last year the Scottish Government introduced a nationally developed set of standardised assessments which all pupils in Scotland complete at key stages during their school career. These assessments focus on literacy and numeracy skills with the results being used alongside a wide range of other school based assessment information to provide a clear picture of progress and achievement on an individual basis.

Testing for our primary one pupils will begin next week. Pupils will complete a computer based literacy and numeracy assessment. As there is no time limit, pupils can take as long as they require completing the assessment but they are typically finished within 30 minutes.

Pupils should not feel anxious about undertaking these assessments. They are adaptive, meaning that the questions can get easier or more challenging as necessary. It is hoped that pupils view them as a fun challenge with the results informing teachers to help enable pupils reach their full potential.
