Home Economics Course

As part of their Home Economics course this session your child will be working through a practical based course. They will take part in a range of practical food and/or textile based activities. We ask that each pupil contribute a one off payment for the year of £25 towards covering the cost of some of the basic materials. It would be helpful if this could be paid all at once, by Friday 6th December, but we understand that this might not always be possible, in which case it can be paid in installments:

Money is to be paid using 'ParentPay'.

In Home Economics pupils are taught about sustainability and the environmental impact of food production. We take our responsibility to protect the environment very seriously and therefore would like to discourage food waste and the use of single-use containers. In line with this we would ask for your support in ensuring pupils come to practical lessons equipped with a suitable container to take their food home in. If this is not possible we can issue a recycled container which can be used for the rest of the year.
