



Language and Literacy activities including:

- Personal reading in class. Discuss and share favourite authors and genres of text. Present a book review to class to encourage a wider choice for personal reading.
- Listening and talking in cooperative learning groups. Use Learning Logs to demonstrate 'My Ideal Classroom'. Discuss how to make changes to our own class.
- Create Mind Maps about Film. Write imaginative stories 1 or 2 characters. Read and research jobs involved in making a film. Complete own job application for Film project.
- Start Breadalbane Primary's Weekly News bulletin. Investigate how to make this entertaining and interesting for the audience.




Mathematics and Numeracy activities including:


- Revision of number processes. Look at digits, their place value, reading, recording, sequencing, adding and subtracting numbers up to and beyond 10 digits.
- Revision of estimation to help addition and subtraction in mental maths.
- Establish maths groups and homework routine. Prepare homework in class and clarify steps for challenge and support.
- Practise and revise calculations using the four operations and be able to explain steps to a partner. Discuss and use BODMAS
- Introduce Problem Solving strategies and discuss the importance of 'showing all my working'.



Health & Wellbeing activities including:

- Establish cooperative learning groups. Play games to encourage praise, participation, group success and class success.
- Teach roles, especially praise and encouragement.
- Follow HWB through film resource from Into Film; research and examine different genres of film.
- As we research film roles class helps everyone to 'find their role' within our class film project.
- Physical activities through PE sessions of hockey, football and basketball. Focus on team work and outside games.




Contexts for Learning: 

This term our topic is Film. We will be studying the technical aspects of Stop Motion animation and discussing why film and storytelling is and has been important throughout history.

We will experiment with stop motion animation in a variety of forms and ultimately create short stop motion films in small groups. We hope to enter these in the Young Indies Short Film competition run by Heartland Film society.
