Dear Parent/Carer

Please find attached a letter we have been asked to distribute by Perth and Kinross Council.

You will note that all PKC schools will be staying open to certain pupil groups. Can I please draw your attention to the following points in regard to arrangements in Breadalbane Academy:

- You will see that if you consider yourself entitled to child care as a key worker and would like to access this from Monday, you should contact the school. If so, please do so at this email address Breadalbane@pkc.gov.uk **by noon tomorrow**. This will allow us to get a sense of the numbers we can expect. Please also, though, complete the PKC survey in attached letter.
- We have not identified specific pupils who fall into the vulnerable category for attendance at school as we are confident other agencies have supports in place for these young people. If however you think your or another child would be better to attend school for these reasons, please do let us know at the above email.
- **Please note that we will not begin targeted work with S4-6 pupils until Wednesday.** Pupils will be contacted directly if they are required to attend. S4-6 children of key workers are free to attend at any time.
- We will try to provide devices for all pupils attending next week to allow them to access support from staff who are homeworking; however, it would also be useful if pupils were able to take in their own laptops/tablets where they have these.
