Now log into Flipgrid. You sign in using your GLOW email. You can now create a short 1 minute video to share with the class. You can add stickers and other cool effects. Flipgrid is on our GLOW Class Team and therefore your video will only be seen by those in our P5 Team. You can watch other people's videos as they post them.

Enter the code baprimary5 and watch Mrs Seward's video 'How to record a video...' about the things you can use to enhance your video. Now think of your best P5 memories and share them with the class in the Memories of P5 topic.
