Dear Parent/Carer,

Please find attached a guide for your child so they know what to expect when they come into school this week. With the exception of PE kits, the guidance in terms of uniform, pencil cases, etc is unchanged from the information shared at the end of last session.

It is particularly important that you and your child are clear on arrangements for entering and leaving the school as there are some changes for pupils who do not come to school by bus or taxi. Therefore I would ask that you spend time reading through the document with your child.

Staff are currently still setting up classrooms and organising resources in line with current guidance. Once this is finished I hope to have a video posted on the school Facebook page so that pupils can see their classroom before they come into school.

You may be aware that we are not returning under the blended learning model therefore all classes, including nursery and GME are attending at 50% tomorrow and Thursday then everyone is in from Friday. If you have forgotten which day your child should come then please contact the school office.

I am pleased to inform you that Mrs Karyn Forsyth was appointed to the post of Sky Room teacher during the holidays and is already in post. Mrs Janet Munro was successful at interview for the nurture job and we are delighted she is able to continue with this role.

I realise that many pupils, and parents, may be anxious about returning to school. Please be assured that we will support pupils with this transition. Should any concerns arise during the school day we will of course let you know.
