S1 John Muir Award Practical Conservation Days Farragon and Lawers
Thursday 1st October and Wednesday 4th November 2020

We are providing the opportunity for every pupil in S1 to continue with, or commence, the John Muir Award Explorer programme through the outdoor education programme. Practical conservation days will take place on Thursday 1st October and Wednesday 4th November for pupils in Farragon and Lawers departing school at 9am and returning at 3.30pm.

We will be working with staff from the Highland Perthshire Communities Land Trust at Dun Coillich and the John Muir Trust at Schiehallion carrying out a variety of conservation tasks. The trips will be fully subsidised by the school and participation by all pupils is expected.

Pupils participating in John Muir Award activities will need to bring a packed lunch and be dressed appropriately for a day in the outdoors in the autumn with strong outdoor footwear (trainers are not suitable), warm, fully waterproof outdoor clothing, warm hat, and warm, waterproof gloves. A small rucksack is recommended for carrying personal belongings.

There are waterproof jackets, waterproof trousers and a selection of walking boots available for use in the school stores.
