Literacy

Learning Intention: to write adjectives
Activity: Design a monster. Colour your monster and add detail. Now label your monster using describing words (adjectives).

- The monster's name.
- What the monster looks like (use your describing words): It has blue eyes and big furry ears. Can you write five sentences to describe it?
- What it sounds like.
- What it likes to eat.

Numeracy

Learning Intention: to count on and back
Activity: Play Find a Number and Count On & Back 1-10 & 1-20. If you find this easy, play 1-30.


⚡ **CHALLENGE!** Can you try 1-50 or even 1-100?!



Learning Intention: to count money
Activity: Set up a shop. Find 5 toys, write 5 amounts on post its or pieces of paper, e.g. 5p, 10p, etc. 'Play shops'- use a calculator as a till register and loose change. If you don't have enough coins, you can make some. Get a crayon and a piece of paper and do a rubbing of the coin then cut it out. Children can be the customer or the shop worker and they need to find the right amount to pay for the items or work out change.

Topic/ Other

Learning Intention: to draw shapes
Activity: Try and find as many different shaped items around the house. Draw round them on a piece of paper and colour to create your own 'shape art'.



- Who they should contact if they find your monster.




Remember posters are:




CHALLENGE! Can you find the correct money to pay for two items together?
