
## Perspective Drawing of an Aquarium


What you will need for this piece of art:

- A piece of paper (preferably A4)
- A ruler
- A pencil
- Colouring pens or pencils


Step 1. Put your paper landscape.




Step 2. Draw a large cross on your paper. Try and get the edges as close to the corners of the paper as you can.




Step 3. Along the bottom 2 lines of your cross, you are going to make markings. This is where you will need your ruler. Start at the middle of the cross, and along both of the bottom lines put little marks at the following measurements: 1cm, 1.5cm, 2cm, 2.5cm, 3cm and 3.5cm.




Step 4. Use your ruler to join these marks horizontally.



Step 5. Along the bottom of the paper, use your ruler and make little marks 3cm apart from each other. Like this.




Step 6. Join each of these little marks to the CENTRE OF THE CROSS.




Step 7. Along all 4 of the lines that make up the CROSS in the page, you are going to put little marks at the following points:


Start from the middle of the cross and measure 2cm, 4cm and then 6cm away from each other.




Step 8. Join these dots to each other vertically.



Step 9. Now you are going to join the lines you have just drawn to each other along the top section with  $\underline{curved}$  lines, like this.



Step 10. Now you have your basic outline of your aquarium! The rest is up to you. You can draw any sort of sea creatures you would like. Sharks, fish, octopus, dolphins. It is your aquarium!



Step 11. After you've done the hard part (the drawing) it's time to colour in! Enjoy decorating your beautiful perspective aquarium.
