What you need	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Items for junk modelling – boxes, bottles, paper, plastic, lids, glue, Sellotape</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A board game that uses a dice, such as Ludo or Snakes and Ladders</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An internet enabled device to watch a video</li> </ul>
Activity	<p>Create a junk model character (a person, animal, robot, car... let your imagination flow!) then create a story about them. Do they have any special powers? It would be wonderful to record your story for SeeSaw!</p>	<p>Play a game together, focusing on counting the spots on the dice, and counting as you move your pieces.</p>	<p>Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> February is Safer Internet Day. Watch the story of <a href="#">Detective Digiduck</a> to learn about how to tell if something online is real or made up.</p>
Extension	<p>Try to create a longer story, focusing on extending vocabulary by using 'wow' words (adjectives), e.g. courageous, generous, speedy.  <a href="#">Wow words</a>    <a href="#">Character words</a></p>	<p>For younger children try completing a jigsaw (some printable jigsaws are below this plan – have fun colouring and cutting them out!). For older children make it trickier with more pieces in your jigsaw.</p>	<p>Discuss with your child the importance of staying safe online. <a href="#">Watch this video</a> about staying safe when playing games.</p>
