<p>Monday</p> <p><u>Live lessons:</u></p> <p>- Maths at 9.30am.</p> <p>-Skill of the week 2.30pm.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To think of and spell words with an 'ur' (super) sound and an 'ow(o)' (awesome) sound.</p> <p>Activity: <u>Super speller words with an 'ur' sound:</u> Church, burnt, curl, fur, purr, purse, nurse, turnip, Saturday and Thursday.</p> <p><u>Awesome Speller words with an 'ow(o)' sound:</u> snow, grow, low, slow, blow, show, mow, row, throw, window, yellow, pillow, follow, arrow, marrow, tomorrow, elbow and below.</p> <p>Copy your words out in 3 different ways: in pencil, coloured pen or pencil and in code. E.g. 1=a, 2=b etc.</p> <p>Write at least 7 silly sentences including at least 2 of your spelling words.</p> <p>Bonus task Try and think of any extra words that have the same spelling sound as yours.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To find a half of a whole number.</p> <p>Activity: For today's task you are finding half of each number by dividing the number by 2.</p> <p>I will be going through examples of this in our live lesson at 9.30am.</p> <p>If it helps use the strategy from last week where you split the number up, divide both parts by 2 and then add the two numbers together to find your answer.</p> <p>E.g. $\frac{1}{2}$ of 64= $\frac{1}{2}$ of 60 + 4= 30+2=32 So 32 is your answer.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To identify ways we can use our Skill of the week.</p> <p>Activity: This week's Skill of the Week is: creativity. I know we have done it before but it is an important one at the moment.</p> <p>There will be a Live Lesson at 2.30pm to go through examples of ways we can use our Skill of the week when completing our Home Learning and when just going about our daily lives.</p> <p>We will be able to share our ideas on the virtual whiteboard.</p> <p>After the live lesson make a mind map like how we do it in our Learning Logs and write when you will use the skills and draw pictures to match.</p>

<p>Tuesday</p> <p><u>Live Lessons:</u></p> <p>-Maths at 9.30am.</p> <p>- Topic at 2.30pm.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To write a recipe for a sandwich.</p> <p>Activity:</p> <p>For today's task your job is to write a recipe for making a sandwich of your choice. It needs to be edible as I am going to follow some of your recipes word for word to make the sandwich.</p> <p>You will need to be VERY specific with what exactly you need to do to make the sandwich as well as the method of how to make it.</p> <p>At the top make a list of the ingredients you will need as well as equipment you will need to make the sandwich.</p> <p>Then underneath write down the steps to take to make the sandwich.</p> <p>I will choose a few recipes to follow and I will show you the results. Good luck 😊</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To find a quarter of a whole number.</p> <p>Activity:</p> <p>For today's task you are finding a quarter of each number by dividing the number by 4 or finding half and then half again.</p> <p>I will be going through examples of this in our live lesson at 9.30am.</p> <p>If it helps use the strategy from last week where you find half of the number and then half again. Use the top of last week's sheet to help you if needed.</p> <p>E.g. $\frac{1}{4}$ of 64= $\frac{1}{2}$ of 64=32 $\frac{1}{2}$ of 32 = 16 So 16 is your answer.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To design your own aquarium.</p> <p>Activity:</p> <p>There is a live lesson at 2.30pm to go through the task.</p> <p>For today's topic task you are going to draw and design your own aquarium using the guide (on Teams and website) to help you.</p> <p>I will send out a template to help you get started but you are welcome to start from scratch if you wish.</p> <p>Don't forget to label the animals you choose to have in your aquarium.</p>
<p>Wednesday</p> <p><u>Live lessons:</u></p> <p>-Share your madlib at 9.30am.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To scan and find information in a piece of text.</p> <p>Activity:</p> <p>Complete the literacy task on Teams and website by doing the following:</p> <p><u>Task 1:</u> Read over the piece of text to find the specific information and answering the questions underneath.</p> <p><u>Task 2:</u></p>	<p>Learning Intention: To complete different mental maths activities.</p> <p>Activity:</p> <p>Over the next few weeks we will be going through the Maths Facts grid (on Teams and school website). For this week work your way through the activities on the Blue or Green Bingo grid. <p>- Share your madlib at 2.30pm.</p>	<p>Find the words in the word search.</p> <p><u>Task 3:</u> Complete the Word Wizard sheet using the Tsunami reading task from last week. Read over the information about tsunamis and find 5 new words you learnt from reading it, write down a short phrase of where it has been used and then write the meaning of the word.</p> <p>Ignore the page part you do not need to do it.</p>		
<p>Thursday <u>Live Lessons:</u></p> <p>- Maths at 9.30pm. -Topic at 2.30pm</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To write a diamante poem about land and sea.</p> <p>Activity: <u>Task 1:</u> Following the instructions, on the Diamante poem formula on website and Teams, write a poem comparing life on land and life in the sea.</p> <p>For this task you will need to know what a noun, adjective and verb is.</p> <p>Adjectives=describing words Nouns=naming words Verbs=doing words</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Write another diamante poem but this time you choose what you write it about.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To add different coins to find the total.</p> <p>Activity: Our next maths topic will be money and this week we will be adding up different coins and notes to find the total amount.</p> <p>There is a live lesson at 9.30am to go through this.</p> <p><u>Task 1</u> (activity sheet on Teams and website) Count the coins to find the total amount. Write the total in either pounds and pence or just pence. E.g. £1.32p or 132p</p> <p>1 pound coin= 100 pence 2 pound coin =200 pence</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Using the link below play the game by selecting the 'counting' game and choose how many coins to count. <p>Friday</p> <p><u>Live lessons:</u></p> <p>- Spelling/dictation at 9.30am for Awesome spellers.</p> <p>- Spelling/dictation at 2.30pm for Super spellers.</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To write down what you hear.</p> <p>Activity: There will be a Live Lesson in the morning and afternoon to go through the dictation of the week with each spelling group.</p> <p>Super spellers are at 2.30pm. Awesome spellers are at 9.30am.</p> <p>Once you have done your dictation with me, have a go at marking it on your own using the dictation PDFs relating to your spelling group. These will be available on Teams after the live lesson.</p> <p>Then once you have taken part in the Live Lesson and marked your dictation, find a quiet spot and read a book of your choice for 30 minutes.</p>	<p>Learning Intentions: To add different coins and notes to find the total.</p> <p>Activity: <u>Task 1</u> (activity sheet on Teams and website) Similar to yesterday count the coins and notes to find the total amount. Write the total in either pounds and pence or just pence. E.g. £1.32p or 132p</p> <p>1 pound coin = 100 pence 2 pound coin = 200 pence 5 pound note = 500 pence 10 pound note = 1000 pence</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Using the link below play the game by selecting the 'counting' game and choose how many coins to count. Then find the total amount and choose the answer that matches your total. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/coins-game</p>	<p>Learning Intention: To create and describe a journey.</p> <p>Activity: For today's topic task using the world map provided (on Teams and website) you are going to plan and draw at least 4 different routes across the world going from one country to another. Then you are going to name the different seas and oceans you may cross to get from one country to the next. Google maps may come in handy for this task.</p> <p>An example has been done for you and will be available on Teams and the website.</p> <p><u>Bonus task</u> Identify the countries you will pass over too.</p>
