Thursday	<p>Adjectives continued</p> <p>Yesterday you created your monsters and then they went missing so you made missing posters to help people to find them.</p> <p>Today, I would like you to have a think about how the monster's friends and family feel about them being missing.</p> <p>You can create a whole family of monsters, if you would like, and then write at least 2 sentences describing how they feel now that their monster family member has gone missing. This time you will have to think about adjectives that describe feelings.</p>	<p>Number patterns</p> <p>We are going to carry on with the number patterns we were looking at last week.</p> <p>I have attached 2 different sheets for you to have a go at. Start with the first one and then go onto the second for a challenge if you're feeling confident.</p> <p>Remember to put a jump in between each number and write down the difference; this will help you to work out what the pattern is. Remember to check if the numbers are going up or down in the pattern.</p>	<p>Make a bicycle</p> <p>Last week we were looking at the invention of the bicycle and how it developed over time.</p> <p>Today, your job is to build your own bike out of whatever you have at home. It could be out of recycling, sticks and leaves you can find in your garden, or anything else!
