It has been lovely having nursery – P3 pupils back in school; the children have settled back in well and there are lots of happy faces in the building. We are looking forward to welcoming back the P4-7 pupils soon.

As earlier on in the session, we continue to try to have the pupils outside regularly during their breaks, lunchtimes and designated outdoor times. Therefore we would ask that children come to school dressed for Scottish weather. In addition, bringing a change of clothes means that pupils can change into something dry if their clothes get wet.

We appreciate that financial circumstances may be very challenging so please do not feel you must buy wellies and waterproofs. We have some unclaimed lost property as well as some spare items within school so if you would like us to see if there is suitable outdoor clothing or footwear please get in touch with me. Families with pupils in primary and secondary (not nursery) who meet certain criteria can apply for a clothing grant of £100 per child.
