Please find attached the final report for pupils in S4, S5 and S6. This report provides the ‘provisional results’ being submitted to SQA for all qualifications. These results have been subject to school and local authority moderation and cannot therefore be changed by the school.

- **Notes on format:**

This is the standard local authority tracking report template, so although we are not reporting at this time on effort, behaviour or homework, we are unable to remove reference to these from the report. We are also unable to change the expression ‘working grade’ so ask that you please note that the grades under this heading are the ‘provisional results’.

- **What are provisional results?**

These are the results the school will submit to the SQA based on pupils’ demonstrated attainment. The table below should assist in interpreting the numerical grades provided.

- **Is it possible the final SQA results could be different?**

The SQA has advised schools that no changes will be made to the results that they submit, so our current understanding is that results in this report are those that will appear on SQA certificates in August.

- **What do I do if I want to appeal results?**

We hope that in all cases pupils will have had a very good idea in advance of the results in this report. If, however, pupils or parents have any concerns about these results, there is a formal SQA appeals procedure that can be pursued. We have previously shared information about this process with parents and it is available on the SQA website.
