

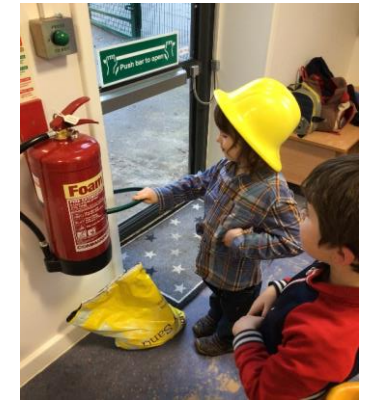
# Nursery news
