P7 Transition

Thank you to everyone who completed the recent survey in relation to our residential trip to Comrie Croft. I can share with you that the vast majority of families wish their child to have the full experience. A small number would like to discuss this further and I will contact those to which this applies over the course of the next week.

The trip, based on your feedback, will now go ahead, and I am now writing to you with more details (see attached flyer) and a booking form for you to complete.

Aims of the residential trip to Comrie Croft:

- To allow pupils from the cluster to meet and begin the process of getting to know each other.
- To enable secondary staff, especially Support for Pupils staff, to get to know the pupils.
- To give pupils an outdoor experience

The Residential will take place from Wednesday 18th May until Friday 20th May 2022 at Comrie Croft near Crieff. The centre is well equipped, and our accommodation will be in the two main buildings. All rooms have bunk bed facilities and accommodate approximately 4-6 people. All catering is provided by Tayside Contracts and pupils will participate in a range of activities provided by school and associated staff with outdoor experience/qualifications.

I can now confirm that the total cost of the trip will be £75.00. We ask that you provide your email address to enable us to contact you directly with all the trip and payment information. Please complete and return the attached booking form to breadalbane@pkc.gov.uk by **Wednesday 30th March 2022**. After you provide your email address, we will send you a link for you to make the payment of the **deposit of £30.00** on ParentPay. **The last instalment of £45.00 will be due on Wednesday 20th April 2022**. The £75 can also be paid in one instalment.

If your child currently attends Breadalbane Academy primary, please make this payment via ParentPay. We appreciate that the necessary cost of some school trips can present a financial challenge and we are keen to support pupils and their families by considering trip bursaries and payment plans where appropriate. If you would like to discuss financial assistance for this trip, please contact the school office. Please note that failure to pay for a trip in advance of it going may result in your child not going on the trip.
