S1 tree planting

We are providing the opportunity for S1 pupils to visit the woodland regeneration site at Dun Coillich to take part in some tree planting and learn about various aspects of conservation and land management. This is part of the outdoor education programme and to contribute to their John Muir Award.

This will take place on the following days:

- 1.1 28th March - Monday
- 1.2 29th March - Tuesday
- 1.3 30th March - Wednesday

Departing from school at 09:00 and returning in time for the end of the school day, 15:40.
Transport will be provided by school minibus.

There is no cost to students.

Pupils participating need to bring a packed lunch including water bottle and be dressed appropriately for a day outside. This includes fully waterproof coat and trousers, and other appropriate layers for the weather. Multiple thin layers are a better option than one heavy layer. A small rucksack for carrying personal belongings and lunch is recommended. If your child does not have any of these items, please contact the PE base to loan items required.

Heartland FM are doing some audio recordings with HPCLT regarding the tree planting project in the area the pupils will be working in. They would like to include some recording of the pupils on site and their involvement. Permission for this will automatically be granted. However, if you do not want your child to be involved in the recording, please let us know by email.
