Costumes for the Upper Primary Summer Production

This year, for the first time in four years, the Upper Primary are presenting a live end-of-year production. All P4-7 pupils are involved either on-stage singing, dancing, acting or off-stage helping with technology, music, props.

Primary 6 and 7 pupils have the main speaking parts and they have been working very hard to learn their lines, practise their parts and learn the songs. We need your help though.

All actors need to be in costume. Primary 6 and 7 pupils, including GME P6 and P7 can tell you what part they are playing. If they did not audition for a speaking part can choose to either dress as a sailor or pirate as everyone will be in costume and singing.

All Primary 5 pupils, including GME P5, are monkeys.

All Primary 4 pupils, including GME P4, are ship's rats.

Pirate Costume

White or red or black un-ironed shirt or tee shirt
Old cut-off jeans – 3/4s are best or black trousers or leggings
Bandana for neck or head
Optional waistcoat

Sailor Costume

White shirt or any stripy tee shirt
Black, blue, or white trousers or shorts
Blue, red, or white scarf

P5 Monkeys

All black or all brown tee shirt and leggings / trousers
Tail if possible
No face-paint please

Black trousers or leggings

You are very welcome to add or adapt any of the above ideas to suit. Please do not feel the need to buy a costume. Local charity shops may have shirts, tee shirts, waistcoats, jeans etc that you can adapt. We also have some costume materials in school so please let the class teacher know if you are having trouble finding something, we can help. ***Costumes should be brought to school carefully labelled with the pupil's name and class. They should be in school by Monday 6th June.***
