Sensory Play

This week we have been experimenting with our playdough. Using different colours of paint and food colouring to make different colours and patterns. There have been a variety of loose parts to add to our creations. We have had lots of birthday cakes, pizzas and magic crowns being made!



Outdoor Play

The nursery children have been learning about patterns, colours, and textures. We took our learning outside to see what patterns we could make with our feet.
