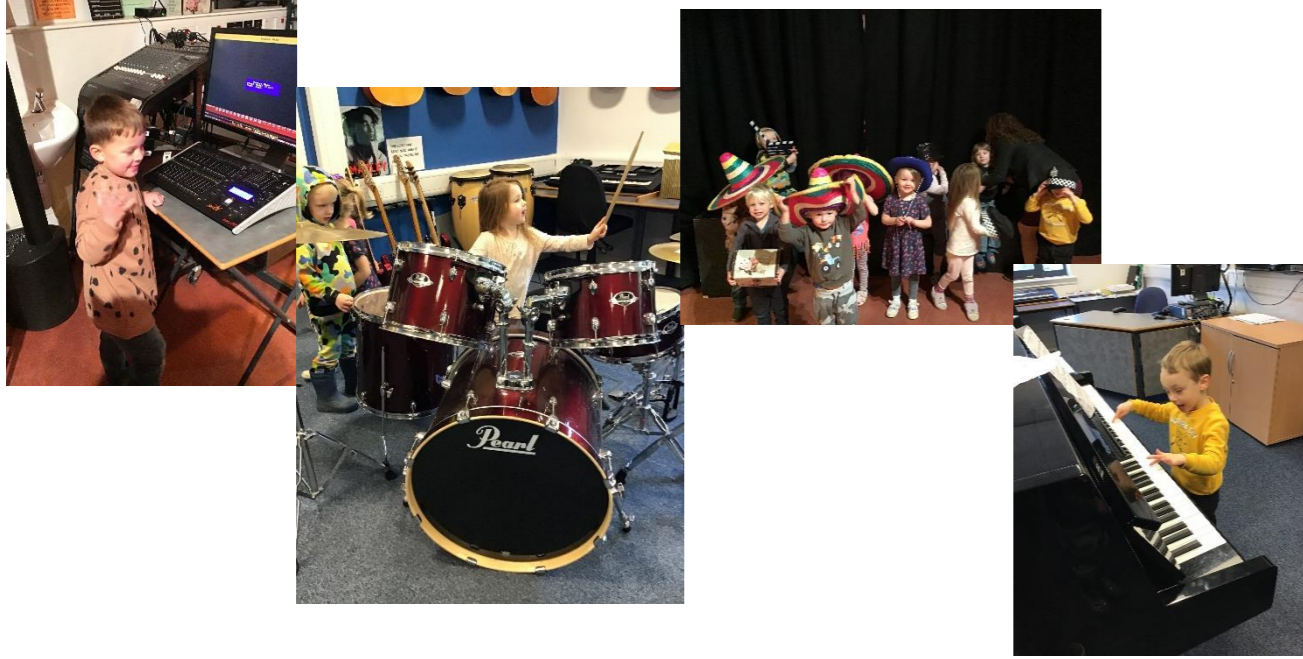

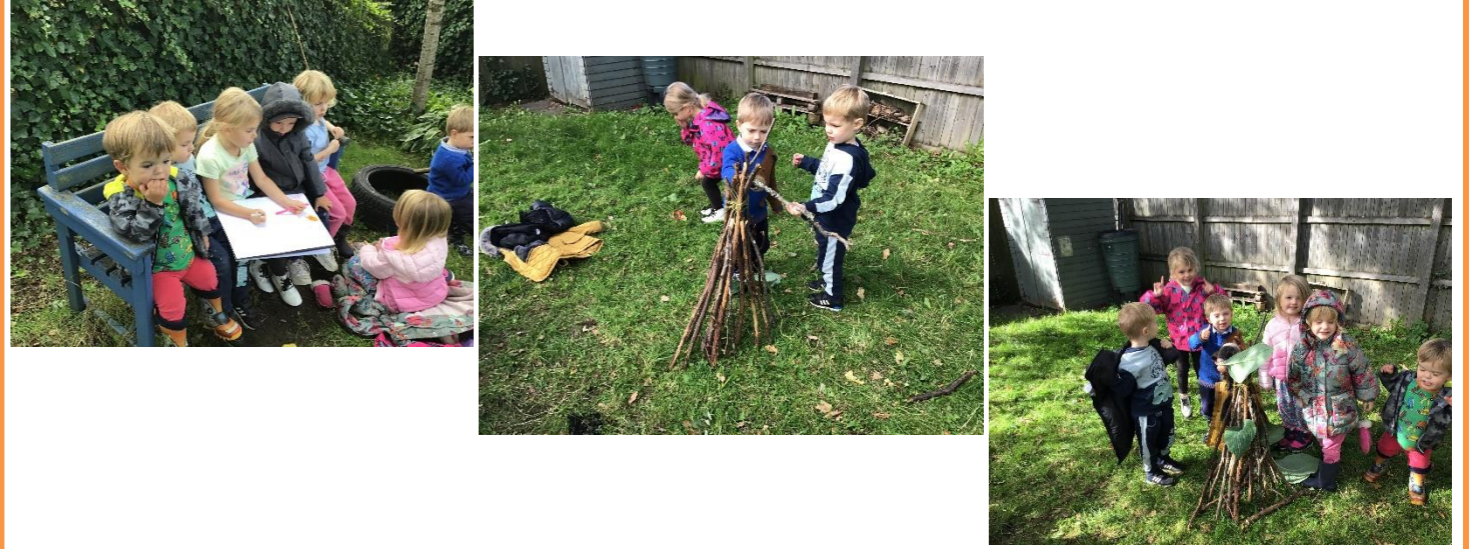
## Secondary Drama Visit
