Dear Parents/Carers

Primary Parent Contact Evenings will be held on Tuesday the 27th September and Thursday 29th September, at which time you will be able to discuss your child's progress this year with their class teacher. Nursery staff will be holding parent contact meetings throughout the week beginning Monday 26th September and parents/carers are requested to sign up for a convenient time in the nursery entrance area. Please note that only one appointment with the class teacher/group leader can be given for each pupil due to time limitations on staff.

In addition to discussing how your child has progressed and settled into their new class this session, teachers of P2-P7 pupils will be able to discuss the results of the recent standardised spelling test undertaken by most students.

We are continuing our recruitment process for a GME teacher; parents of P1-3 pupils will meet with Mr Poole and P4-7 pupils will meet Mrs Jenkins. Mrs Jenkins will have information from Mr Poole regarding the progress P4-7 pupils are making in their Gaelic learning. Both Mrs Jenkins and Mr Poole will be carrying out their appointments on Thursday 29th September.

For pupils in the Sky Room class, Mrs Peters is available to meet parents on the Tuesday evening.

While class teachers have an overview of any support pupils are receiving, if you wish an appointment with acting Pupil Support Teacher Mrs Munro for the Tuesday evening please indicate this on the attached slip. As part of her Principal Teacher remit, Miss Wallace oversees nursery and support and is available to meet parents on either evening. Should you wish to meet with Mrs Marshall on either evening please indicate this on the slip. Mr Devine is available to meet parents on Thursday 29th September.

Whilst we recognise that most parents are keen to return to this, for some parents, telephone appointments are easier.
