### **Seesaw**

Seesaw is used for Nursery to Primary Three pupils – older pupils use Microsoft Teams. We started using the app during lockdown as a way for pupils to share their learning with staff. When pupils returned to school it



was then used for pupils to share homework. Nursery continue to use it to document pupil learning, this has extended into P1. However once pupils are in P2 they use their Learning Logs more to reflect on their learning. As homework has now changed to be reading only, the use of Seesaw has greatly reduced. However, we welcome pupils sharing what they have been reading or other learning at home.

We are aware of some parents having issues with the app if they are using it for more than one child. The fix for this varies depending on the individual devices. Our nursery teacher Mrs Hunter is managing to support parents by phone, email or, sometimes, in person so she can see the device.
