Christmas Jumper Day/Christmas lunch – Friday 16th December

For Christmas Jumper Day, jumpers may be worn over school uniform. Do not worry if you do not have a jumper as we have spare tinsel for those who want it. Donations for the non-uniform day can be made through ParentPay.

Christmas dinners have been ordered but please make sure that packed lunches are provided for those who have not chosen the dinner option.

Nativity – Tuesday 20th December

No tickets are required for the Nativity, open to family members of performers, simply turn up and take a seat. There are two performances as follows:

Afternoon Performance – Doors open at 1.15pm. Performance starts at 1.30pm

Evening Performance – Doors open at 5.45pm. Performance starts at 6pm

The event comprises the choir, Nursery, dancers and the Nativity itself. For the evening performance, the Nursery will perform before the main Nativity. Please collect your child immediately after their section. You may then either take your child home or re-join the audience to watch the nativity. Choir and dancers can equally be collected after their session or are free to re-join the audience until the end of the whole show. For those staying, the anticipated collection time is **7.15pm**
