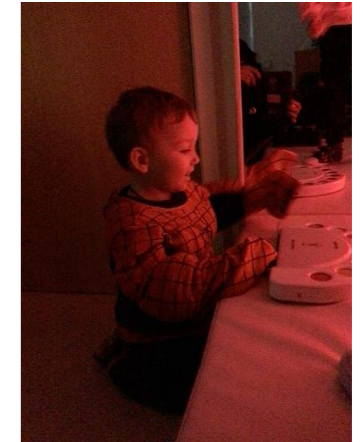
## Outdoor Learning

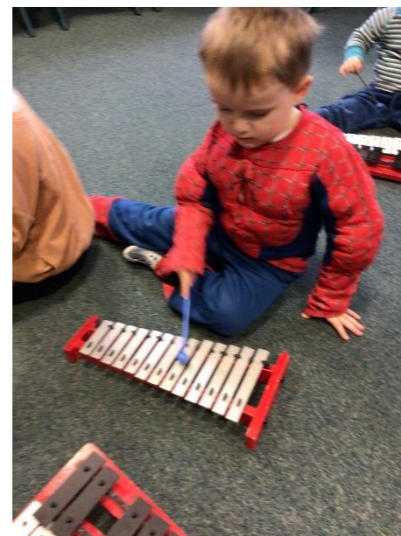
## Sensory Room
