Outdoor Education Programme - New S3 Munro Walk

As a part of the Breadalbane Wider Achievement Guarantee, we are providing the opportunity for all new S3 pupils to take part in a hillwalking day in Munro terrain. The aim is for pupils to enjoy a day out exploring a mountainous environment in a small group. Groups will decide their goal for the day together, alongside the staff accompanying their group, so that everyone has a day that is appropriately challenging and enjoyable.

The walks will take place as follows:

- **Pupils in 3.1 - Monday 15th May**
- **Pupils in 3.2 - Tuesday 16th May**
- **Pupils in 3.3 - Monday 5th June**

Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle(s) – no cans please. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals they will be provided with a packed lunch. The form [here](#) must be completed and returned one week before their walk is due to take place. School uniform is not required, and pupils should be dressed appropriately for a day outside.

Pupils participating will need to wear:

- Strong outdoor shoes or walking boots with thick socks (not trainer socks)
- Trousers/leggings/joggers (not jeans)
- T shirt
- Jumper or fleece
- Warm hat and gloves (if it is cold)
- Sunglasses, hat, suncream (if it is sunny)

Equipment required for the day:

- small rucksack – 2 straps suitable to be carried all day
- waterproof jacket and trousers
- spare jumper and warm hat
- any essential medication required e.g. Inhalers

If required, there are waterproof jackets and trousers available for pupils to use at school.



There is no cost associated with this walk and it is covered by the Annual Consent Form completed at the beginning of the school year. If there are any changes, please contact the school by calling 01887 822300 or email breadalbane@pkc.gov.uk.

If you wish to withdraw your consent for your child taking part in this activity, please email breadalbane@pkc.gov.uk by the end of the school day on Friday 12th May.

Finally, please note that as this is a normal school day, pupils are required to attend school, irrespective of whether they take part in the walk.
