S2 Water Sport Experience

As part of the Breadalbane Wider Achievement Guarantee we are providing the opportunity for all S2 pupils to take part in a local water sports day experience.

This will take place as follows:

- Tuesday 5th September for pupils in 2.1
- Wednesday 6th September for pupils in 2.2

The trip will be heavily subsidised by the school to encourage participation by all. The cost will be £25 per pupil which includes transport from school, equipment hire and full instruction. Payment must be made via ParentPay by Friday 1st September. By subsidising the trip, we hope that the cost will not be prohibitive, however, we appreciate that the necessary cost of some school trips can present a financial challenge and we are keen to support pupils and their families by considering trip bursaries and payment plans where appropriate. Pupils will depart school at 9am and returning by 3.30pm in time for the school buses. They need to bring a packed lunch and drink – no cans please. Packed lunches can be supplied by Tayside Contracts and paid for via ParentPay. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, a packed lunch can be provided for the trip in place of the in-school lunch. If you would like to order a packed lunch, please complete the form here and return one week before the trip is due to take place.

This trip is covered by the Annual Consent Form that was issued to all pupils at the end of last term. I year. If you have not already returned your completed form to the school office, please ensure you do so by Friday 1st September. If there are any changes, since submitting your form please contact the school and let them know. If you wish to withdraw your consent for the trip, please contact the school office before Friday 1st September.













School uniform is not required, and pupils should be dressed appropriately for the day. Pupils participating will need to bring:

- swimwear girls: one-piece costumes only
- long-sleeved top to wear underneath the hired wetsuits
- shoes that will get wet (no flip flops or sliders)
- towel
- full change of warm, dry clothing including shoes
