Under the sea

This week's 'under the sea' learning was about keeping our sea and beaches clean. We talked about how litter can get into our oceans and how it can affect the wildlife. We have set up an under the sea tuff tray full of animals and plastic items which the children have been sorting using tweezers. Miss Menzies also made some under the sea themed ice for use to try and get the animals out of.



Bug hunt

Our role play area has turned in to a bug identifications zone. We have a real-life worm jar where we are learning what a worm needs to eat. In the garden this week we have found a huge range of beasties that we have been identifying.



Experiments

This week we have made some sensory lava bottles using oil, water, food colouring and glitter. Everyone has a go at measuring and pouring their ingredients in to their bottles.



Other Information
