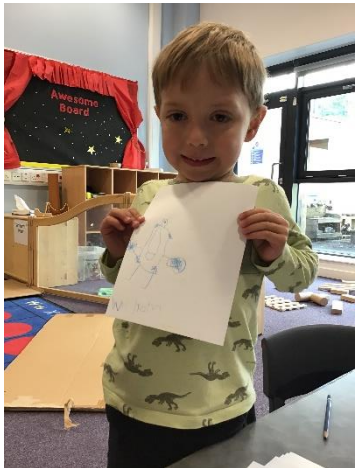
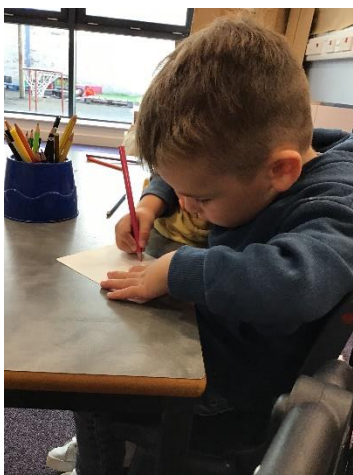
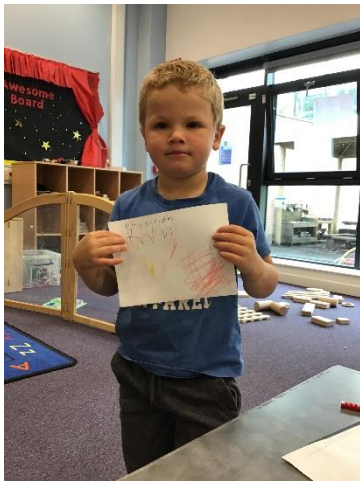
Play on Pedals

Miss Crouch has started to run the play on pedals for the nursery children. This is a weekly focussed group and all children will have a chance to take part in this over the year. It focusses on bike safety, knowing the parts of the bike and learning to ride both balance bikes and pedal bikes. On the week your child is due to take part we will ask for verbal permission for your child to join the group.



All About Me

We are carrying on with our learning about what makes us different. This week we have been look at our names. We have explored the alphabet and identified familiar letters. Some have the children have began to practice letter formation and write their own names!



Under the sea

This week we have been continuing with our under the sea learning. The children have asked to learn about sea turtles, dolphins and animals that live in swimming pools. We have been incorporating fine motor skills, number and letter recognition in to our creative activities.



Other Information
